Pine Ridge Riders ■ All tenderfoots' welcome! You can learn a lot about yourself atop the saddle of a 1200-pound horse. This camp is intended for beginner to intermediate riders who are looking to grow in faith while learning the basics of horse riding, grooming and care. Then you will be ready for the rugged trails of the Chadron State park. This week will also include a rodeo at Fort Robinson State Park on Thursday and a talk on horse care and ministry by Pastor Paul Smith. All this, plus a ton of activities at Camp Norwesca, including western crafts, worship and bible studies. This is going to be a wonderful week full of Wild West Adventures.

Grades 3–12 (although considered an open enrollment camp, campers will be split by age) | \$375 per person (includes t-shirt, water bottle, & bag) | **June 18–23**

F.I.C.M. Camp (Future Leaders of Camping Ministries) ■ Ever wondered what it is like to be a celebrity?!? Well, being a Camp Counselor is pretty close. Unwind next to a crackling campfire, singing songs, roasting marshmallows, listening to the crickets sing in the midst of God's beautiful creation.

Pine Ridge Riders (Level 2) ■ Howdy intermediate advanced riders! This camp is geared towards campers with at least 2 years riding experience (must be comfortable trotting and loping). Dust off your hat, polish your boots and hit the most rugged trails at the Chadron State Park. This week will also include a talk on horse care and ministry by Pastor Paul Smith. On Thursday you will hit the trails at Fort Robinson and attend a rodeo that night! You will also be participating in team-building, nightly campfires, western crafts, Bible studies, worship, and so much more. So, put your spurs on and mount up for a great week partner.

Summer Camp Discounts

- **Camper Referral Discount:** For each new Summer Camper you refer, you will receive 10% off your camp fee. Your camper's friend will also receive a 10% discount. There is no limit on the number of people you can refer! You could come to camp for free! The new camper must put your campers name in the “How did you hear about Camp Norwesca?” box when registering. *This discount does not apply to referrals made to people in your immediate family or previous campers.* You must contact the Camp Office after both campers have registered to receive this discount.
- **Night Owl Discount:** Register for Summer Camp before **March 15th** and receive **\$30 off** Registration. This discount cannot stack with the Camper Referral Discount or Early Bird Discount.
- **Early Bird Special:** Register for Summer Camp before **April 15** and receive **\$15 off** registration. This discount cannot stack with the Camper Referral Discount or Night Owl Discount.
- **Sibling Discount:** Save \$10 when you and your sibling register for summer camp! To receive this discount, you must type in the code: **Sibling** when registering or contact the camp office. It will not be applied automatically. The Sibling Discount can be combined with the Night Owl or Early Bird Discount.
